Anna Elizabeth Zeisberg, affectionately known to her friends as 'Annelise' passed away on August 28 at Mary Health of the Sick in Newbury Park. Annelise was born in 1925 in Heinrichau, Germany. She met her future husband, Fred Zeisberg, in the American PX after the war. They married in Bremen, Germany. As a child in Germany, Annelise dreamed of living where the 'Indians' lived and in 1954 she and Fred crossed the ocean in pursuit of her dream. While working as a tailor in Milwaukee, a customer happened in that Anne recognized from her dress design trade school in Germany. She too had immigrated to the US. Shortly thereafter, in 1956, Annelise and Fred followed this friend to Santa Barbara after hearing about the beauty of the area.

Annelise continued her work as a tailor in Santa Barbara, working for I. Magnin department store and others throughout her tailoring career that spanned fifty years. Annelise also loved her garden and her attention to detail resulted in a meticulously cared for and ever-changing landscape. She moved plants, removed plants, and was always looking to improve her lovely garden.

Annelise's creative talents spilled over into her kitchen. She effortlessly absorbed the culinary skills of many global cultures.

Annelise enjoyed the last three years of her life with the Sisters Servants of Mary, residents, and staff, at Mary Health of the Sick in Newbury Park.

Annelise is survived by her daughter, Ingrid Giammichele, and son-in-law, Brian, along with four grandchildren, Colin, Shannon, Christian, and Kieran Giammichele. Annelise was preceded in death by her husband, Fred Zeisberg, and son, Ron Zeisberg.
