Daniel L. Wagner was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin, and attended Santa Barbara City College, where he earned an Associate of Arts degree in Political Science. He served in the U.S. Army from 1959-1961, then transferred to reserve status until his honorable discharge in 1965.

Daniel graduated from the California Highway Patrol Academy in 1966 and was assigned to serve in the Los Angeles County area. In 1968, he transferred to the Santa Barbara area, where he spent the remainder of his career before retiring in February 1982, after 16 years of dedicated service.

In January 1972, Daniel married the love of his life, Joyce Marie Chariton, and together they made Santa Barbara their home.

In addition to his work with the Highway Patrol, Daniel founded Dan's Chauffeuring and Valet Service in 1968, driving for a wide range of clients across the United States and British Columbia.

Daniel and Joyce were also known for their generosity and hospitality, often opening their home to college exchange students from around the world.

A devout Christian, Daniel loved the Lord with all his heart. He was an active member of Oaks Bible Church and Calvary Chapel in Santa Barbara, regularly attending bible studies and services. He also served with the local Gideon's chapter from June 2012 up until his death, handing out bibles at UCSB, Santa Barbara City College, and many local schools. He was well respected and loved within the ministry of the Gideons International and his church communities.

Daniel was preceded in death by his beloved wife Joyce, and his parents, Henry Louis Wagner (IL) and Clara Lydia Raether (WI). He is survived by his sister-in-law, Janice Angell, niece Mellany Archer, and nephew Mark Angell, all of Colorado.

Daniel's legacy of faith, service, and friendship will be remembered by all who knew him.
