Eloise Catherine Uranga Srednicki, beloved wife, mother, and sister, passed away on December 12, 2021 of natural causes, at home with her family.

Born in Oakland in 1955, she was raised by her loving parents Prudencio and Betty Uranga in Newark, the eldest of eight children. She was a proud graduate of Moreau Catholic High School in Hayward, then earned a BS degree in microbiology from San Jose State University, where she also began a lifelong love of theater and dance. She trained as a Clinical Laboratory Scientist at Burlingame Hospital, and then held that position at several hospitals and health centers. While training she met her husband-to-be Mark Srednicki. After living in Princeton, NJ, and Geneva, Switzerland, the two settled in Santa Barbara, where they raised their daughter Julia.

Eloise worked in real estate and as a substitute teacher, was a leader and trainer for Girl Scouts, and was active as a lector and choir member at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church. She performed with numerous local theater and dance companies over the years, and was also an avid painter and gardener.

She is pre-deceased by her brother Andrew and sister Janet, and survived by her husband Mark and daughter Julia, brother Eric, sisters Sally, Cynthia, Joyce, and Christina, and numerous nieces and nephews. She was much

loved and will be greatly missed by her large extended family and many friends.

Funeral services will be held at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Church at noon on December 20. Burial will follow at Santa Barbara Cemetery.
