“ *Raised by adopted parents Edith and Emil Colantonio in the vibrant Italian Immigrant Community of Chicago after losing her Italian born mother to a fatal sepetis infection and abandoned by her dispossessed father at birth. Moved to Southern California in the mid 40s to attend High School and marriage to husband Ted at 19, raised 4 children, while working the night shift in accounting at Security Pacific bank in downtown LA. Moved to Claremont CA in 1966 with the help of a generous wealthy Museum benefactor, Elizabeth Borwell. Started seasonal Christmas help at the May Department Stores Co. in sales in 1972 and moved into an opening once again in her speciality, accounting, where she retired in 1997 after more than 25 years. Eurella, "Lu" lost dearly beloved husband Teddy to a sudden heart attack in mid summer of 1980. Never remarried. Developed severely debilitating osteoporosis within months after retirement which she courageously battled throughout the rest of her life, along with successfully overcoming thyroid cancer in the early 2000s. Died peacefully at Serenity House in Santa Barbara after emergency hip replacement surgery at the Cottage hospital. Spent one night with each of her children to say her final goodbyes. Throughout her life and turmoil of an ever expanding clan, and ever diminishing capcity, she remained the anchor of the Baumgartner family traditions, ever kind and gracious Wife and Mother, to the end.*
