Evonne Kruck at 53, born in Brooklyn, New York has passed away at Serenity House from cerebral cancer October 10, 2012 at 2:50 AM at Santa Barbara, California. Evonne lived and had started pursuing her advanced study of photography at Brooks Institute in Santa Barbara 4 years ago.

Evonne was more than just a photographer though; she was a confidant; trustworthy to hold your secrets for safe keeping. She was wise person; always knowing just what to say, even if it wasn't what you wanted to hear. Fun and creative; always ready for an adventure, wanting to ride that roller coaster again or go in the haunted house just one more time. She was someone who made bunny cakes from scratch for Easter and green pancakes and eggs for St. Patrick's Day. She was someone who set up tents in the living room and made s'mores in the fireplace when it was too rainy to camp outside and she gave the best hugs. Evonne was determined and strong willed; she knew what she wanted and went after it. She was dedicated in everything she did and never gave up. The photographs she took show these things; her creativity, her passion, and her determination to always get that perfect shot. She was held close and loved by so many.
