



## Dr. Garvan F. Kuskey

August 24, 1933 - September 21, 2015

A Mass of Christian Burial for Dr. Garvan F. Kuskey will be celebrated at Our Lady of Sorrows Church on Friday, September 25, 10AM followed by internment at Calvary Cemetery.

He was preceded in death by his father, Frank Kuskey, his Mother, Mary Kuskey, and his sisters Pamela Kuskey and Patricia Kuskey.

Dr. Kuskey is survived by his wife of 57 years, Mariana, four children, Teresa Nowak (Ray), Eric Kuskey (Anita), Elena Falossi (David), and Anna Lisa Lemos (Ricardo), and 25 grandchildren.

Dr. Kuskey was born in Santa Barbara at St. Francis Hospital in 1933 and attended Santa Barbara Catholic High School. He received his undergraduate degree from UCSB, where he was president of Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity. He also served as president of the Inter-Fraternity Council, and was a member of the Blue Key Honor Society. He received his dental degree from the University of Southern California. After graduation he served in the U.S. Army for 3-1/2 years in Mannheim, Germany where he operated a dental clinic. After returning to Santa Barbara in 1963 he went into private practice. He saw patients at his 1515 State Street office for 52 years until his retirement last year.

He was a 3rd Degree Knight of Columbus and a long-time member of the Serra Club. Of all his civic activities, his favorite was his more than 40 year association with the Santa Barbara Trust for Historic Preservation and the project to rebuild the Presidio. He served two terms as President of the organization. Donations in his memory to that organization would be appreciated.
