She fully enjoyed 92 years of life with her husband, her children, grandchildren, and many friends.

Jannette was born in Dubuque, Iowa to Irwin and Lillian Renier and had fond memories of growing up with brother James, and sisters Mary, and Pauline. She was educated in Dubuque at the Visitation Academy and Clarke College where she was awarded a BA in Mathematics. During this time she also worked in the family's business, Renier Music Co. Jannette took advanced studies at the University of Hawaii, and the University of Chicago in Mathematics. While attending the University of Chicago, she compiled statistical data for medical doctors conducting cancer research at Billings Hospital. She traveled extensively, including an around-the-world academic tour.

Jannette and Howard were married in the Chapel at the University of Chicago on December 29, 1956, and moved to Phoenix, Arizona, where their three children were born. They loved raising their children in Phoenix, then Los Altos, California, and finally Santa Barbara.
