JONATHAN E. JORDAN died October 16, 2014 at the age of 52 years old.

Jon was born March 14, 1962 in Denver, Colorado to Clifford E. Jordan and Margaret J. Jordan.

Since age 4 Jon was raised and made his home in Santa Barbara, California after his family moved there in 1966.

Jon attended Laguna Blanca School, Howard School, Bishop Garcia Diego High School and Santa Barbara City College.

Jon was an accomplished poet and writer and received a Certificate of Excellence in Poetry from UCLA. He received a degree in Theology; was a devout believer in our Lord Jesus Christ and thoroughly understood and could quote the Bible in an instant. He also extensively studied World Religions, all aspects of Science including Astronomy and read everything Einstein had ever written. Jon was thrilled that he and Albert Einstein shared the same birthday.

Jon had a wonderful humorous side to him and could keep people in "stitches" with his humor and jokes. No matter what the day brought Jon, he always had a joke at the ready. He loved having philosophical conversations with his father on all topics from A to Z. He was forever grateful to his mother for the love and encouragement she always gave him throughout his life. Jon was

elated at the birth of his grandnephew, Jameson and said that he could always see the Holy Spirit shining through Jameson's eyes. He loved dogs and was looking forward to a day in the near future when he could adopt a dog in need of the love and care that Jon had to give.
