November 22, 1928 - December 25, 2011

BORN NOVEMBER 22, 1928 WENT HOME TO HIS LORD ON DEC 25. 2011. NORMAN WAS BORN IN LOS ANGELES CALIF, AND MOVED TO SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA IN 1930. HE WENT TO GRAMMAR SCHOOL AT PEABODY SCHOOL, LA CUMBRE JR HIGH AND GRADUATED FROM SANTA BARBARA HIGH SCHOOL IN 1947. HE WORKED FOR GENERAL TELEPHONE FOR 40 YEARS. HE REMAINED TRUE TO THE COMPANY FOR HIS ENTIRE LIFE, ALWAYS BUYING ONLY VERIZON PRODUCTS. HE MARRIED JOANNE BOWMAN IN 1949 .NORMAN WAS THE LOVE OF JOANNE'S LIFE HIS FAMILY WAS HIS GREATEST LOVE. HE ENJOYED WOODWORK IN HIS YOUNGER YEARS. HE AND JOANNE TRAVELD 11 TIMES ACROSS THE NATION TO SEE THEIR CHILDREN, GRAND CHILDREN AND GREAT CHILDREN. HE WAS A FAITHFUL MEMBER OF TRINITY LUTHERAN CHURCH FOR 58 YEARS.
