Survivor of the St. Francis Dam disaster of 1928, Sally's will to live and bravery saved her on that disastrous night. She continued to live her life courageously up to her last breath. She and her family worked tirelessly in the fields of Santa Paula, where she met the man who would be her lifelong husband. In June 1935, she married Ray (Happy) Arroyo, and came to live in Santa Barbara. Together they shared true love, built a home and raised their children. At the final hour of her life she was surrounded by her devoted family and loving friends as she went to join Ray in Heaven. She is survived by brothers Alfred Luna, Frank Luna, David Luna.
