



William Robert Lucas

May 29, 1932 - May 27, 2011

Bob graduated from Woodbury University, served in the armed services as an Air Traffic Controller and founded Lucas & Company in 1957. Bob's firm later became Lucas, Horsfall, Murphy & Pindroh, LLP. Bob remained the managing partner until his 70th birthday. At the time of Bob's death, the firm had grown to over 50 CPAs and support staff.

His many years of public service included volunteer Police Reserves in South Pasadena for 7 years, South Pasadena YMCA, Kiwanis Club and the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce.

Bob and his wife Dorothy moved to Santa Barbara in 1989, where Bob became very active in several charitable and non-profit groups including: the Rotary Club of Santa Barbara, Girl Scouts, and the Salvation Army.

Bob was an active Board member of his Alma Mater's Board of Trustees for 28 years and in May of 2010. Woodbury University awarded Bob with an honorary Doctorate in Business Administration for his many years of service to the University.

He was preceded in death by his parents, two stepsons, Pat and John Murphy. He is survived by his wife Dorothy, six children: Sharon, Jody, Jim, Colleen, James and Cindy, eleven grandchildren and many other friends and relatives.
